Rules

- No complaining
- Stay together, no going off anywhere alone
- Guys and girls sleep separate from each other
- No going off anywhere without an adult knowing
- Do everything that your church leaders, chaperones, and Mission Arlington leaders tell you
- When doing service projects/Rainbow Express, be on your best behavior (Mission Arlington has a great reputation in the community that does not need staining)
- No foul language, crude jokes, slang terms, or any other use of words which can be ungodly/unwholesome.
- No pranks, unless permitted by an adult.
- No posting pictures of the kids you work with, unless you blur their faces.

Mission Arlington's Dress Code

Mission Arlington does have a dress code as follows: "Mission Arlington's dress code is very basic. We ask all participants to dress modestly, comfortably, and in something where they are ready to work. Casual dress is fine all week long. Here are a few specific requests we make of all groups: Shorts are fine, please **no short shorts**. Footwear is up to you, but because we do so much work and active play outside we recommend tennis shoes over flip-flops. T-shirts are great to wear, but please **no tank tops or any other kinds of sleeveless shirts**. Baseball caps are fine, but please wear forward at all times. Do **NOT** wear bandanas or any other type of head gear. We ask that students and leaders **DO NOT** wear leggings/tights/yoga pants/'jeggings' unless they are wearing a long shirt or sweater that would cover everything normally covered by a pair of shorts. Please remember that there are certain things you might wear at home working outside in the heat but that may not be the right image for knocking on doors and asking parents to let their children go with you."

Packing list

- Plenty of clothes for 6 days (1 day at the waterpark, 1 night at a baseball game and 2 travel days (Keep in mind it will be hot, so you may need multiple sets of clothes for each day.)
- Swimsuit (Girls must bring a one piece, tankinis, or shorts and dark colored t-shirt. NO bikinis.)
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, DEODORANT/ANTIPERSPIRANT, soap, shampoo, towels, or anything else you need to shower, remain fresh, and to keep me from smelling you)
- Air mattress, cot, etc., with bedding (sheets and blanket OR sleeping bag) and pillow
- Sunscreen
- Money for 5 fast food meals and any extra you may want for the waterpark or other things during the week (Please be wise with your money)
- Thermos/refillable water bottle
- Backpack for your change of clothes (You can share with a friend.)
- Towel for waterpark
- Appropriate pajamas
- Your favorite snacks, cereal, and/or pop-tarts to share
- Any medications you may need
- Bible
- Heart willing to serve and an attitude to match!
